<b>DISCUSSION</b>	<p>11/6 received news from Dr. Trujillo that TUSD would not reopen on 11/12/20 due to 2 categories falling into the yellow zone for the Pima County Health Board COVID benchmarks.</p> <p>There was a possibility of 147 students who were supposed to start on hybrid 11/12/20. We still have students on campus – Ex. Ed., KIDCO, and high needs. Bonillas has not had any cases or concerns regarding COVID since we opened in August. We have a new custodian. We are up to 2 custodians who are cleaning the campus.</p> <p>As of right now, TUSD may open January 4 or the 11.</p>

<b>DISCUSSION</b>	<p>Currently in our account is \$4274.25.</p> <p>We used \$89.82 for 3 gift cards (2 first place gift cards for the Cookie Fundraiser and 1 gift card for Schiavone to give out). Names of top selling classrooms and students will be provided by Schiavone when the cards have been given out.</p> <p>Cookie Dough Fundraiser: Total profit was \$661.86</p> <p>Check will be mailed to school. The reward prizes from the Cookie Dough Fundraiser will be delivered to the school not to the students' home. There are 13 registered sellers so Ms. Dixon will work with Ms. Boring to get prizes to students when prizes arrive.</p>
