DISCUSSION	<p>Current Funds Tax Credit Fine Arts 5, OMA 400 Sports 2058.03 Field trips 3100 Art 1600 Undesignated 11,381.91</p> <p>Currently have 5086.65 for fine arts, 2,482.79 in Overall total tax credit left over is 8899.12 or 9000K left for the year</p> <p>KidsArt – art program in the spring.</p> <p>Encumbered</p> <p>Forecast Right now with no other donations, we will be able to sustain one more year of coaching and that's it. We pay for sports, coaches, and any tournament fees is out of tax credit. W/o tax credit we will lose this founding. We need more tax credit donations. We cannot purchase coaches or materials out of other budgets. Any student who wants to participate in extracurricular program, at least \$25 dollar tax credit donation to the school (per activity – track and field / softball / basketball / soccer). The state of Arizona will give it back to you when you file your taxes. Dual families can donate up to \$400 (married). Anyone regardless can donate this amount. Funds will generally be in “undesignated funds” so we can move funds as needed. (Field trips, undesignated, or sports)</p> <p>Magnet Certification We are in the process of becoming National Mage 1 – letter grade of A or B 2 – ethnicities intergrated 3 – magnet certified school (we are working on this right now; lengthy process and working on it this year with Ms. Karen Wilson)</p>
