



Dear Bonillas Families and Community Members,

Thank you all for your continued patience and support during the past nine weeks of school. I understand that this temporary model is not always the best way for educating students. Teachers and staff members, as well as students have been working extremely hard to make sure the year is successful. Thank you to all parents that have been so supportive.

Next, the TUSD Governing Board met on Tuesday, Oct. 2nd, to discuss a hybrid model for returning to school as well as a start date. The hybrid model was approved, however the start date was not. The Governing Board will be meeting again on Tuesday, Oct. 27th at 5:30pm, to vote on a start date. Once that date comes, families will have two options: At Home Learning or Hybrid Model. An email communication from the district has already been sent out.

- **Remote:** Students continue at home all days. Students work on asynchronous activities (independent) from 8:30am to 12:30pm. After lunch, students will work with their teacher live on Zoom for direct instruction till the end of the day at 2:45pm.
- **Hybrid Model:** Students come to school in the morning till 11:45 Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday for direct face to face instruction with their teacher. After lunch, students work on asynchronous activities (independent) till the end of the day (2:45pm). Students remain at home all day on Wednesdays and participate in Zoom instruction and online learning with their teacher. Once in the Hybrid model, students onsite will need to wear uniforms.
- **KidCo:** Parks and Rec KidCo at Bonillas is offering programs during closure as well as when we switch to the hybrid model. Please know that spaces are limited.

If you have any further questions regarding the hybrid model, please reach out to our front office. All families must log into ParentVue by Nov. 1st and select their choice of Hybrid or Remote. The process should take no more than five minutes and it is required to be completed to move forward with instruction.

Please know that Bonillas is dedicated to keep all students and community members safe. We look forward to seeing everyone soon. Thank you!
