



Dear Bonillas Families and Community Members,

First, I want to thank reach and every community member (students, families, and staff) for the outstanding support and patience you all have shown to start off the 'virtual' school year. I know that moving to an online platform has been challenging for everyone. While this isn't the ideal way to learn, we will continue to do what is best for our students. I look forward to when we can all be together again in person.

Next, while students adjust to the online platform, it is important that students continue to treat online time as if it was the normal school day. While it is difficult for students to stay seated for long periods of time, I have asked that teachers give opportunities for movement and brain breaks. Please make sure students are following the same school rules while at home so when we do return, students will not have difficulties transitioning. Here are some recommendations:

- Remind students to eat during break and lunch times
- If possible, allow for students to be seated at a table sitting up straight.
- Give students a few extra minutes in the morning to log onto their zoom.
- Make sure students have a rest time from screen use at the end of the day.
- Understand that other students and teachers can **hear** and **see** what is going on in your student's home. Please mindful of language and appropriate actions of video.
