We the parent(s) or guardian of _____ understand that our support and participation is essential to our child's success of the program and will:

- Follow TUSD Policy Regarding Attendance/Tardies: Regular attendance is vital to your child's success in school. If your child will be absent please ensure you call to excuse your child's absence. Students who are tardy or absent (doctor visits with doctors notes are not included) more than 4 times in a quarter, will have a letter sent to the parents and a copy will be placed in the student's permanent file along with a referral to the school family liaison. Students that are checked out early from school will be considered either a ½ day absence or tardy (depending on the time the child is checked out). **ONLY LEGAL GUARDIANS ARE PERMITTED TO CHECK OUT A CHILD EARLY FROM SCHOOL.** If anyone else will be picking up your child from school, including anyone listed as an emergency contact, the legal guardian must call the office and inform them prior to the student being released. Emergency cards are **ONLY** used by the school, in the event that there is an emergency and the parent cannot be reached, **IT DOES NOT GIVE PERMISSION FOR ANYONE OTHER THAN THE LEGAL GUARDIAN TO PICK UP A STUDENT EARLY.**
- **Support Homework Efforts:** Please work to provide a time, place, and appropriate atmosphere for homework to be completed each night. In addition, parent(s)/guardian(s) are asked to review and sign all homework. Students may be required to serve lunch detention to finish any incomplete or late homework assignments.
- **Support the Discipline Policy:** Our school provides a disciplined, tightly structured, calm, and orderly atmosphere. Respect, courtesy, friendliness, and cheerfulness is encouraged and practiced by staff and students. This all is necessary to assure an orderly learning environment, in which every person is able to live and learn to his/her full capabilities in harmony with others.
- **Support the Bonillas Positive Behavior Intervention System (PBIS):** PBIS is used to ensure that all students are safe and making good choices everyday. We use the Character Counts approach to help guide the choices students make at our school. Our plan focuses on the Six Pillars of Character- Trustworthiness, Respect, Responsibility, Fairness, Caring, and Citizenship. Students are recognized for exhibiting positive character traits. For students who make poor choices, the TUSD Guidelines for Students Rights and Responsibilities are used to assign consequences appropriate to the action. Each family will receive a copy of this book at the beginning of the new school year, and parent and student assemblies will be conducted each semester to review this information.
- **Follow the Bonillas Dress Code:**
 - **Pants:** Tan, Black Navy. Cotton, twill or corduroy, **UNIFORM STYLE ONLY. NO JEANS OR JEGGINGS OF ANY COLOR ARE PERMITTED. LEGGINGS (PREFERABLY SOLID COLOR) MAY ONLY BE WORN UNDER APPROVED BOTTOMS DURING COLDER WEATHER. SWEAT PANTS ARE NOT ALLOWED.**
 - **Shoes:** Closed toe shoes with socks should be worn. No open toed or high heeled shoes are permitted.
 - **Shorts/Skorts/Skirts/Jumpers:** Tan, Black, Navy. Cotton, twill or corduroy, **UNIFORM STYLE.** Must be at least fingertip length, although knee length is preferable.
 - **Shirts:** Any solid color polo shirt, **UNIFORM STYLE,** short or long sleeve with collar (with or without buttons), turtleneck shirt, or button down shirt. No artwork of any kind is permitted with the exception of clothing with Bonillas Logos purchased from the school.
 - **Hair and Accessories:** Hair should be neat and clean and should not be distracting in appearance. Hats are permitted outdoors only and must be worn properly. Jewelry should be modest. No large earrings (hoops) are permitted. Make-up of any kind is **NOT** permitted.
- **Support rules regarding use of cell phones:** If children bring a cell phone to school, it must remain off and in a backpack during school hours. If a cell phone interrupts the class or is used during school hours, it may be taken and kept secured in the office for a parent/guardian to pick up. We encourage students to keep cell phones put away at all times while on school grounds. If a student needs to use the phone to call home, they should ask the teacher to use the classroom phone. **Please be advised that bringing personal items from home (phones, balls, toys, games etc.) is at your own risk and highly discouraged. The school will not accept responsibility personal items brought from home if lost, stolen, or damaged.**
- **Consult** with teacher, principal, or other school personnel involved with my child on a regular basis
- **Participate** in parent/teacher conferences, parent meetings, and school projects and events.
