Below is a very brief summary of our plans for the upcoming weeks.

- **School Closure:** All schools across AZ are closed through the end of the school year.
- **Meals:** FREE Grab-n-Go meals (breakfast and lunch) will be provided for all students. Students must be present to receive the food. A map of locations is posted on our school website at www.tusd1.org/bonillas. If you need assistance finding locations, please call (520) 225-4700. One of the buses will be at the Bonillas bus bay every day from **10:41 – 10:51am**.
- **Instruction:** Teachers are available via email over during the school closure. Please feel free to reach out to them during normal school. All staff emails are located on our Bonillas website under staff. In addition, the district has put together an outstanding resource online for students to access curriculum. All resources can be located on the top of our school webpage. We do understand that many students do not have access to technology and the district is providing paper copies of resources for students.
- **Drop by and Pick Up:** In order to better support our students, the district will be issuing computers for students with no technology at home. It will be similar to a drive through. Just pull into the main parking lot, roll down your window, we will give you forms to be completed and then you will receive a device. Any one handling the materials and devices will be wearing gloves.

 - o **Wednesday, April 29th 10am – 4pm:** 2nd – 4th Grade
 - o **Wednesday, May 6th 5:30 – 6:30pm:** Make up day for all grades
