ITEM TITLE	Gold Card Gifts
DISCUSSION NOTES	<p>We sold 262 cards.</p> <p>We have 4 kids who are going to be doing the money bag grab. Boring will send the students' names to Schiavone and schedule how and when to do it.</p> <p>None of the teachers won the gift card because they were supposed to sell a certain amount.</p> <p>To win a movie party, a class was to sell 40 or more cards. One class sold 48 cards, however, 40 of the cards came from one child alone. 8 other cards came from one other child. Technically this classroom won.</p> <p>There was one class that sold 28 cards and 10 kids in that classroom that sold cards.</p> <p>There is a question if the movie party should go to the classrooms or should just go to kids who sold 5 cards or more.</p> <p>Sarah will need to send a list of the students who sold cards to Schiavone so he can figure out a way to reward those kids who gold cards.</p> <p>Ms. Lamm sold the most cards in the entire school, but the sales came from 2 students. Mr. Escobar sold 28 cards and 8 kids in his classroom that sold cards.</p> <p>Overall, there were 18 students in the entire school that sold 5 gold cards or more.</p>



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	<p>Several questions discussed include: How much would it cost to have both classes earn a movie party instead of just one? How do we celebrate with kids who are at home vs. in the classroom? Should we have parties for the two classes or just the students who sold card? Can we do movie night in the courtyard or in the cafeteria? How is it fair to rewards an entire classroom if only 2 students sold cards in that classroom?</p> <p>Boring, Schiavone, and Pate all agree to honor the students who sold cards.</p> <p>Schiavone is asking for the list of students in order to see who is on campus and who is remote. If the kids are at home, he will see if they are interested in coming to Bonillas to participate in Movie Night.</p> <p>Based on where the kids are, Schiavone will decide if it is going to be two classrooms or just the 18 students. Pate also suggested to see if the kids are interested especially if it is in the evening and it's more about rewarding kids who sold than keeping the class together.</p> <p>The tablet will be delivered by Amazon Prime tomorrow and Schiavone will raffle it off.</p> <p>The Dancing Robot was raffled off and the winner was Oliver Chapman.</p> <p>For the money grab bag: 4 kids will go to the money grab bag There will be \$50, \$20, 2 tens. Boring will send the money and names of students who will participate to Schiavone. Boring will also make up the names for the tablet raffle and send them to Schiavone.</p>
