



Bonillas Traditional Magnet Elementary School Testing Procedures During COVID 2021

It is very important that all families in the Bonillas community are aware of the test administration procedures that ensure valid and reliable administration of our statewide assessments. **It is most important to note that all Arizona statewide assessments must be administered in person.** We do not have remote proctoring options available for testing this spring for any of our statewide assessments.

In Person Students: All in-house Bonillas students taking statewide tests will do so in their classroom with their teacher serving as the proctor. Remote students will come to Bonillas on the scheduled test date and will take their assessment in the computer lab with room 10A serving as an overflow site. The Bonillas Core team will proctor all remote test takers. Fridays have been set aside for any, and all, makeup testing. The first two weeks of May are also set aside for makeup testing. Arrangements can be made for makeup at other times with regard to parent and student schedules.

Safety Protocols on Campus: All possible safety protocols will be taken while students are on campus. Masks must be worn, social distancing to best possible degree, the use of desk screens when appropriate, students encouraged to bring their own headphones, air filtration purification systems have been installed all testing rooms, and all rooms will be sanitized at the end of each testing session.

Transportation: Families that want to take advantage of TUSD bus transportation only need to call the Bonillas office to find out their assigned bus route. Upon completion of a day's testing, remote students can either call home and return to their house to continue remote learning, or they can remain at Bonillas for the remainder of that day, in the computer lab, engaged in remote learning from the lab. Students who remain at school will have district snack and lunch provided. Students are encouraged to bring water, but not a backpack to Bonillas for test days. Students will use the rest room one at a time and follow the Bonillas restroom policies.



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Accommodations: All special needs accommodations will be available and adhered to for all qualifying Bonillas students. Disruptive students will be removed from a testing location and continue their test in a new location.

Scheduling: Students are scheduled for only one statewide test on any given day. This means that students in grades 3 – 5 will need to come to campus 5 – 7 times in the month of April. See the above testing schedule. All remote students who miss a testing opportunity will be contacted for the purpose of rescheduling. Families who choose to not have their child participate in statewide testing need to communicate with the school as soon as possible.

Testing this spring will be challenging, but very important. Please call the office at Bonillas with any questions, or concerns regarding your child's statewide testing experience.
